

## Village Patisserie relocates to Conifer

The Village Patisserie might have a new location, but the bakery is holding fast to its farm-to-table roots and firm dedication to the benefits of butter over shortening.

The European-style pastry shop has relocated from Marshdale to Conifer and set up shop a few doors down from Big R. The shop still gets as much of its baking supplies as possible from local sources, still plans to host cookie- and cupcake-decorating parties, and still displays local artwork and crafts for sale.

"We've just picked up where we left off," said owner Dave Knight.

Knight said the new space is better for parties, baking classes and other group activities. It also has a long wall of built-in shelving that's perfect for displaying the artwork. Also, the King Soopers center gets more traffic.

"This (space) just seemed to fit," Knight said.

Knight said he hopes the next new thing for his business will be making chocclate in-house. But for now he just wants his loyal customers to find the Village Patisserie's new home.

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"It's picking up," Knight said. "People are beginning to know Where We are."
